It is very muddy on our field so only children who bring wellies in are allowed onto the grass. Don't forget to put their names in the wellies.

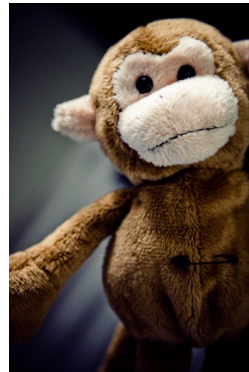
### P.E

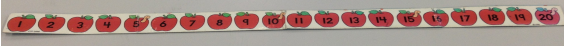

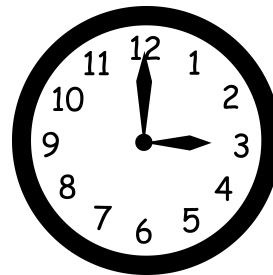

We have been learning about money. The children have been adding up small amounts and starting to think about giving change.



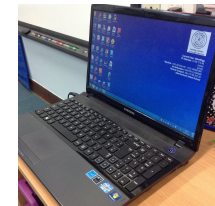
We are learning to tell the time to o'clock and half past. This is something that you could practise at home.
