Sun cream and hats!

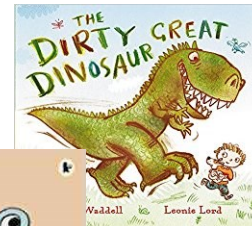
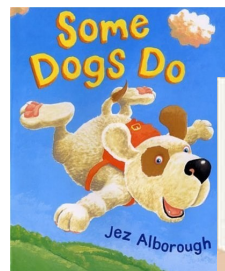
The weather is getting hotter now and, with the sun out more, please encourage your child to wear a hat and use sun cream when outside.
