It is very muddy on our field so only children who bring wellies in are allowed onto the grass. Don't forget to put their names in the wellies.



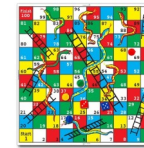
### P.E

Our enquiry is games and play around the world

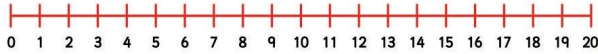
Our story is We're going on a Bear Hunt

What other words can we use for +, - and = ?

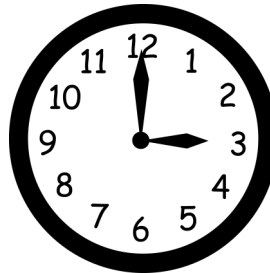
Look at these numbers

We are learning

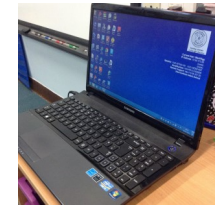
to tell the time to o'clock and half past. This is something that you could practise at home.
