
Children will be learning the stories;

- The children will publish their stories into books and share with Year 3 children during their shared reading sessions with WEJS.
- The children will play language and sentence games regularly in order to prepare them for the Y2 Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation assessment (SPAG).

The second half term the children will learn the story;

'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon', and rewriting their own story.

They will write about their learning enquiry 'What happens in the sea?' and write about the British seaside in the present day and in history.
