



Covid-19 update Wednesday 18th March 2020

Dear Families,

As the latest advice is now that anyone with

- New persistent cough
- High temperature

has to self-isolate for 7 days and anyone living with that person/child has to self-isolate for 14 days, this has had a significant impact on staffing.

It means that I have already made the difficult decision to close nursery until further notice and may in the future have to partially close or fully close school.

The safety and welfare of the children and staff continues to be my first priority and we will continue to operate as normally as possible as the government is advising schools to do.

However, with the strong possibility of school shutting before the Easter holiday, staff are preparing resources/activities to do at home to support your child's learning. We will share these with you, if and when we do shut.

Finally I want to reassure families that to date, we have no confirmed cases of covid-19 (a positive test) and will continue to ensure children and staff are maintaining good personal hygiene and that the school is cleaned to a high standard.

Thank you for your understanding at this exceptionally difficult time.
