#### Full reopening of school

It has been lovely to finally welcome everyone back, this September and to once again hear the voices and laughter of children fill the school. Staff have been very impressed at how quickly most children settled into school and how familiar they are already becoming with routines.

All of our children have been learning our 4 simple school rules **Be safe, Be kind, Keep trying, Show care**, to ensure that their school experience is a happy one with lots of fun learning.

Year 2 has enjoyed learning about the Great Fire of London this half term and were very understanding when staff set fire to some of the houses they had built! Year 1 has been learning about how plants grow and growing their own beans. Mulberry class has had a big focus on keeping safe, including fire safety. Reception and Nursery have been exploring their new environment indoors and outside and learning about harvest and autumn.







#### Remote or Home Learning

In case we are instructed to close the school again, or in the event of having to send a year group 'bubble' home, or a child needs to self-isolate, we have put in place some home learning ideas on our school website. There will be more information about home learning if and when it is needed.

#### Travelling Bedtime Stories & Maths Monkey
