Notification of an asymptomatic covid case in Conkers nursery class

Dear Families,

I am writing to inform you that we have learnt today, of a positive case of covid19 in the Conkers class (nursery).

This is an **asymptomatic case of covid19**, meaning there were **no symptoms**. I have taken advice this morning from the **Outbreak Management Team** and as the case had **no contact** with children and staff 48 hours prior to the positive test, **no further action** is required and no one other than the case and the people they live with, needs to self isolate.

Please can I remind you that it is important that if you or your child displays any symptoms of covid19; new persistent cough, lack of smell or taste, high temperature, you must self isolate immediately and get a test. Lateral Flow Tests (LFT) can pick up asymptomatic cases, but if someone is unwell and displaying symptoms these are not to be used and you need to book a PCR test.

Whilst cases of covid19 are dramatically falling across the country and Norfolk, this case emphasises that covid has not disappeared and that we all need to continue to practise social distancing and the wearing of masks (adults) in communal places.
