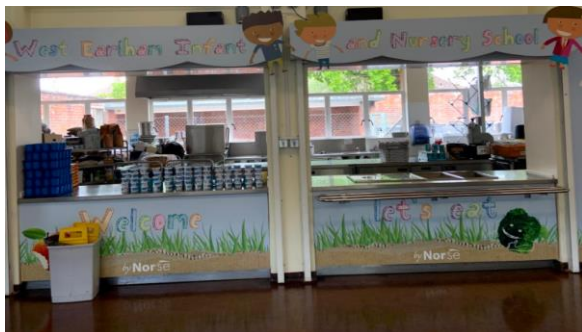


School lunches

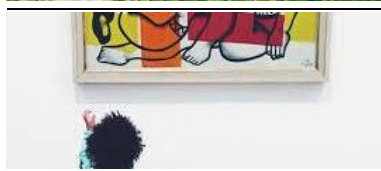
Teams
