Latest Covid 19 guidance



Dear Families,

Guidance to stay at home if you test positive

Adults and children who **test positive** are now being advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for **at least five full days** and then continue to follow the guidance **until they have received two negative test results** on consecutive days up to and including Day 10.

At WEINS we will be following Norfolk County Council guidelines for maintained schools and all of our staff will continue to self isolate should they have coronavirus. However, we want to do all we can, to ensure that school and nursery remains fully open, **because if staff test positive and need to self isolate**, classes may need to shut.

Here's a reminder of the measures we still have in place to keep our school fully open

	<p>You call the office if you are unsure if your child is displaying covid19 symptoms, or your child has had a positive LFT</p>
	<p>You dress your child warmly, as we will be keeping doors and windows open as much as possible</p>

Reminder of symptoms in children

Although the government has never updated their list of covid19 symptoms, since the start of the pandemic

- Loss of smell and taste
- Continuous cough
- High temperature
- It is worth knowing that **fatigue, headache, loss of appetite and a rash**, have been recorded in some children infected with **Omicron**, so please look out for these as possible symptoms too.
