Minutes:

1. Go through the results of our survey and discuss

Mrs Marriage went through the results from the survey about travelling to school. We could see that half of the children walk to school, and that most children at the school travel on foot (walk or bike/scooter). Mrs Marriage explained the pie chart and what each colour shows. The school council members will share the results with their classes.

The school council members commented:

"Mostly people walk"

"That means there's not so much traffic and less smoke in the air."

"If you're walking, that means you are exercising and being healthy."

2. Recap the ways to stay safe when travelling to school which we discussed and ask school council members if they have made any observations since then. We recapped the ways we discussed to stay safe when travelling to school and the school council members remembered what we had talked about last time. One school council member said "I notice lots of kids running about on the pavement." Another said "Sometimes I see bigger kids running around on the way to school." Mrs Marriage commented that she sometimes sees children running away from their grown up to catch up with a friend. The school council members said they had not noticed people being unsafe in the road.

3. Creating posters to display outside school.

- Walk in the middle of the pavement
- Don't walk on the grass
- Signs for safe parking
- Signs for crossing the road
- Keep hold of hands / pushchairs
- Reminders to look both ways when crossing the road

Can we come up with a good slogan?

Some suggestions were:

"Walk safely on the pavement"

"No running"

"Always stay with your grown up"

"Leave space for cars"

"Be careful when you park"

"Cross safely here"

The school council members will share these ideas with their class.
